This physical example extends into his mental philosophies as well – he wants to exercise all parts of the brain equally and help others do the same.

Trent is one of the most trustworthy people you will ever meet. Every ounce of him is made of the nicest human being and when he says his mission is to help people learn, laugh, create, explore, and become their best selves – he truly means it.
